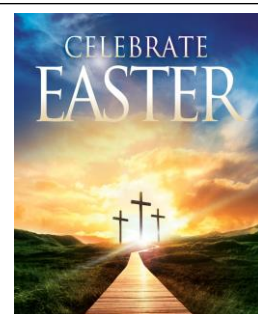
May 6 at 7:00 PM – The choir will be singing at Pine Branch Baptist Church in Mouth of Wilson.
